Polemiken in der Geschichte der Linguistik

Von den Anfängen der Vermittlung klassischer oder auch moderner Sprachen bis in die neueste Zeit gab es zwischen einzelnen Autoren oder gar unter Vertretern ganzer Schulen immer wieder polemische Auseinandersetzungen, die sich in vielerlei Hinsicht niederschlagen konnten. Auch wenn im Nachhinein wohl nicht alle Polemiken unbedingt die von ihren Betreibern erwünschten Auswirkungen mit sich brachten, so scheint der Konfliktbereich zwischen althergebrachtem und neuen Überlegungen in der Geschichte der Sprachwissenschaft besonders untersuchenswert.

Darüber hinaus laden wir herzlich zu Beiträgen ein, die sich mit einem beliebigen Thema aus der Geschichte der Sprachwissenschaft befassen.

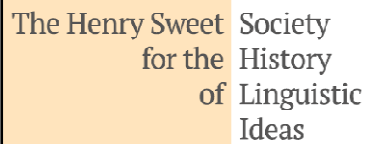
In addition, we also cordially invite papers dedicated to any topic in the History of Linguistics.

In many ways, we associate these beliefs with certain 'canonical' works, to which the literature ascribes an exemplary function in relation to works that appeared later. Are these divisions as clear-cut as we often think they are, or perhaps not? We look forward to all contributions that deal with this issue.
